

Solid Waste Plan

Goals:

- 80% diversion by 2020
- 10% per capita waste reduction

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Metro Vancouver's solid waste plan has goals to divert at least 80% of the waste we produce by 2020


AND to reduce the amount of waste we produce in the first place by 10%




New disposal bans on organics (and clean wood) were the single biggest tools Metro has used to get organics out of the garbage...




... these used to be typical of loads we'd see with large amounts of food disposed



...and correspondingly INCREASED the amount of organics being sent to composting.



Organics disposal ban has significantly REDUCED the amount of organics in the garbage...



...and correspondingly INCREASED the amount of organics being sent to composting.
